
What's New in FirstClass Web Services 12.1 - Service Pack 1

FirstClass Web Services 12.1 - Service Pack 1 has a large number of bug fixes that will not be discussed here. This document is intended to present visual and functional changes that have been implemented with this release.


Desktop Changes



• The **Contacts** and **Voice Greetings** folders which were mistakenly displayed on the desktop have now been removed.



• Workspace sidebar header no longer has a zoom button as it is always full height. The Mailbox and Calendar sidebars are adjusted accordingly filling the entire height with content.




• **Voice Greetings** has been added as a new workspace item if voice services is installed. (See below for more information.





• Click and hold on a container on the desktop no longer reveals an 'X' for deletion. it now brings up a menu list for operating on iconic items



• Click/Touch hold on a my people unread blob icon will clear the flag like elsewhere.

Chats

• A new video chat option has been added for browsers that support video.



If your browser supports video, you can start a video chat with another person whose browser also supports video.


To start a video chat, open the person's chat pane just as you would if starting a text chat. Use the **Initiate Video Chat** button at the top of the chat pane to send a video chat invitation.



If the other person accepts, you will both be asked for permission to use your cameras and microphones. After you both accept, the video chat opens in the chat pane.

You can move the video chat to a resizable window in the center pane by using the **Zoom** icon in the top right corner. Closing this window stops the chat. To move the video chat back to the chat pane, use the **Zoom** icon again.

Contacts Importing contacts



• You can import contact information to your FirstClass Contacts folder or a contact database. This information must be in vCard 3.0 format.

To import the contact information from a vCard (.vcf) file, open your Contacts folder or the contact database to which you want to import this information, choose **Import Contacts** from the **New** button's dropdown menu, then choose the file to import.

Exporting contacts

You can also export FirstClass contact information. This information is exported in vCard 3.0 format.

To export a contact, choose **Export** from its menu. You can select multiple contacts and export them in one file. You are given the opportunity to rename the export file.

Note

You can't export mail lists.



Auto Contact Creation




• Depending on your preferences, replying to someone who isn't in your organization will automatically create a contact representing that person in your Contacts folder. If you don't want this behavior, clear the **Auto create contact for external recipients** checkbox in your preferences.


Calendars

Creating events and tasks in Sub calendars

You now have the ability to create events and tasks within sub calendars



Importing calendar items




To import the calendar items from an iCal (.ics) file, open the calendar to which you want to import the calendar items, choose **Import Calendar** from the **New** button's dropdown menu, then choose the file to import.

Events are converted to FirstClass events and to-dos are converted to FirstClass tasks.

To import calendar items to a sub calendar, open a calendar that has the sub calendar available, choose the sub calendar from the **New** button's dropdown menu, then choose **Import Calendar**.

Exporting calendar items


• You can also export events and tasks from a FirstClass calendar.



They are exported in iCal 2.0 format.

To export an event or task, open it, then choose **Export** from its menu. You are given the opportunity to rename the export file.

Adding Google Calendar







•The menu location for adding a Google Calendar has changed from the New Event menu to the Filter Menu

Community Layout


- The layout for communities has has a few display changes




Miscellaneous Enhancements
