

## **Travel Agents in Cyberspace**

Flying FirstClass with STA Travel Global Campus

### STA Travel Global Campus

Are there travel agents in cyberspace? Certainly – however, they aren't virtual tourist guides but student travel agents training online at STA Travel Global Campus. Developed by the New Zealand School of Travel and Tourism (NZSTT) and managed by its Internet Learning Business School (ILBSNZ), STA Travel Global Campus delivers the same curriculum that STA Travel Australia – part of the worldwide STA Travel organization – offers through face-to-face training. Like its classroom counterpart, the virtual Campus offers accredited travel and tourism courses approved by the Australian Travel Training Review Panel (ATTRP) and leading to an Australian Level 3 Certificate in Tourism (International Retail Travel Sales).

As Sue Smith, Managing Director of STA Travel Australia/New Zealand Division, points out, "...many conventional travel courses are cost and time prohibitive, particularly for people making a career change." Online courses, on the other hand, give students the chance to study at their own pace, in their own environment. Patrick O'Keeffe, a student at the Campus, concurs: "I have a full-time job, so I do all my studying after hours."

### A FirstClass training environment

Cyber-schools face the challenge of preserving the human element in a virtual setting. STA Travel Global Campus has done a good job of making students feel they're part of a community with a common professional goal. An Intranet environment with private and public areas, the Campus is powered by FirstClass, a groupware product from Centrinity, the Canadian-based global software developer.

FirstClass is a robust, highly scalable software solution that enables educational organizations and businesses worldwide to communicate, collaborate, publish online and deliver distance training using state-of-the-art client-server technology and application development tools. Groups can customize FirstClass, making its seamlessly integrated Intranet/Internet environment into an online home. Like all FirstClass Intranets, STA Travel's virtual Campus is structured around *conferences* (online forums) and a private mailbox. Conferences contain the course curriculum, assignments, group tutorials, detailed information on courses and jobs, plus a network of newsletters, notice boards and chat rooms. Additionally, FirstClass enables users to post and manage multimedia-enhanced documents and customized forms. Students can also visit the Student Café for a real-time chat. STA Travel Global Campus is a veritable one-stop solution offering student travel agents both training and guidance – a simple way to click-start a career.

### Training by modules


Once they register, students receive a user ID and password, a CD-ROM with software and resources, an STA Travel Global Campus manual and access to a Mentor, a designated person who is their guide and helper on the Campus. They then select the course they wish to study and purchase the modules as they go. For instance, the AFTA qualification is comprised of 10 modules, including popular fares and ticketing modules internationally accredited by IATA/UFTAA. Students focus on three modules at a time. Once they register for a module, they're automatically given access to the module's content, which

has been posted to a Campus conference. Each module takes about 30 hours to complete successfully. A gradebook application is used to track the students' progress, and another application is used for online testing. At the end of the course, STA Travel considers all participants for the position of STA Travel Adviser.

### Online learning today and tomorrow

"There are times when you like to upgrade your skills or continue learning...but it may not always be possible - and this is where ...the Campus is a life saver," comments Milton Batres, a student at STA Travel Global Campus. When time is of the essence, training in cyberspace may just be the ticket to an exciting future in global travel.



### Registration with Centrinity's fcNewUser

fcNewUser, an application created with the help of server-based FirstClass Rapid Application Developer (FirstClass RAD\*) tools, automates the online registration process. Students complete a customized application form, attach their photo and submit the application electronically. They receive immediate confirmation by email. Course selection is also automated using another FirstClass RAD-based application. All kinds of Intranet applications and powerful database interfaces can be built with FirstClass RAD, a tool that's part of a single, comprehensive integrated system based on proven FirstClass core architecture. FirstClass RAD has a sophisticated object-oriented, eventdriven interface, which makes building applications easy enough for nonprogrammers, yet fulfills the needs of seasoned professionals.

RAD is part of the latest version of FirstClass.
